

Analyzing Primary Resources

Objective: Students will learn to analyze primary resources.

1. Visit the National Archives Website at <http://docsteach.org/>
2. Select the "Find Documents" link.
3. Students will explore Historic American documents and practice reading primary sources. This page contains links to hundreds of Primary Source documents. Students may browse through the documents and select five documents that interest them.
4. Once students select a document, they must select the correct document analysis form and complete it. This must be done completely. Fill out one full form per document.
