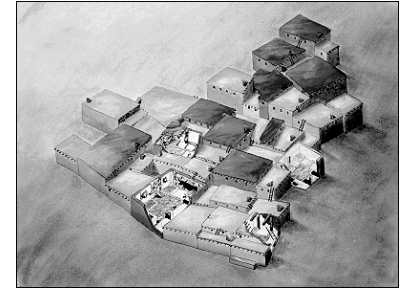




You will create two mini comic strips side by side that are “opposite” to one another. One will show “Life in Border Cave” or the Old Stone Age and the other will show “Life in Catal Huyuk” or the New Stone Age.



REQUIREMENTS FOR AN A:

1. You must include a title, proper punctuation, complete sentences, highlight vocabulary words and details.
2. Includes 5 **important** differences between the Old and New Stone Age. **HIGHLIGHT YELLOW**
3. Include 2 **important** similarities between the Old and New Stone Age. **HIGHLIGHT ORANGE**
4. Uses 8 **significant** vocabulary words correctly from our list **HIGHLIGHT PINK**
5. Includes a description of each scene that includes specific details about Old and New Stone Age life.
6. Use specific details for both Old and New Stone Age in your drawings and descriptions.

For example specific details include: began making spears from obsidian. **HIGHLIGHT GREEN**

1. I can describe the daily life of hunter-gatherer communities. (Ex. Old Stone Age tools, shelters, diet, use of fire, life in Border Cave, art [Lascaux or other caves])
2. I can describe the daily life of early agricultural settlements. (Ex. Domestication of plants and animals, New Stone Age Tools, surplus, specialization, trade and towns such as Catal Huyuk).
3. I can compare and contrast hunter-gatherer communities with agricultural communities. (Ex. Geographic setting, choice of work, nomadic or settler life, Border Cave and Catal Huyuk).
